There aren't too many things to report since our last meeting 2 weeks ago. Just a couple updates:

- 1) Our word for the month of October is gratitude. We will be talking about gratitude throughout the month, emphasizing its importance to healthy development.

For example, last year, we completed lessons on different emotions (joy, anger, frustration). These groups are a great way to build camaraderie, leadership, and belonging in the school.

In grade 5 and 6, they are used more often. Students create presentations, are sometimes allowed to listen to appropriate music, and can use them for STEAM activities, like 3D printing and design.
