Our Division is committed to fostering a community of diversity and belonging for all learners as defined in our Three-year Plan of Inclusive Education. During the 2023-24 school year, Palliser has supported 246 self-identified First Nations, Metis and Inuit students. The Division emphasized learning of Indigenous perspectives, student well-being, building relationships with local Indigenous groups, understanding of residential schools and how to address learning gaps. Our Indigenous Success Coordinator, Kylie Fineday, has shared resources, educational opportunities and student success stories with regular newsletters.

The Terry Fox Foundation acknowledges the generosity of 16 Palliser Schools in supporting the 2023 Terry Fox School Run with \$14,529.80 raised in support of cancer research.

The Alberta Govt. provided teachers, parents and other staff an opportunity to provide input about cellphone use in schools through an online survey which closed on May 03. Also, the ATA passed a motion, at their recent May annual general meeting, in support of restricting smartphones in classrooms during instructional time. All this input will help inform potential future govt. direction. Palliser is working to create a procedure, in consultation with other southern Alberta school divisions, on cellphone use in the classroom.
